From 1992-1995, Bosnia suffered through a terrible war. The war ended with a peace accord that left many victims with little or no justice, and many communities struggling.

Since 2000, the New Jersey Synod has gone to Bosnia each summer to work with the children of Bosnia sharing God's love through healing, hope, & peace.

Each year we hold Friendship Camps throughout the country, focussing on music and art therapy, cooperative challenges that build self-esteem and teamwork, and diversity training through drama. Each year we have 2,500 participants from all ethnic backgrounds at these Friendship Camps. These Camps change communities and lives - both theirs and ours.
